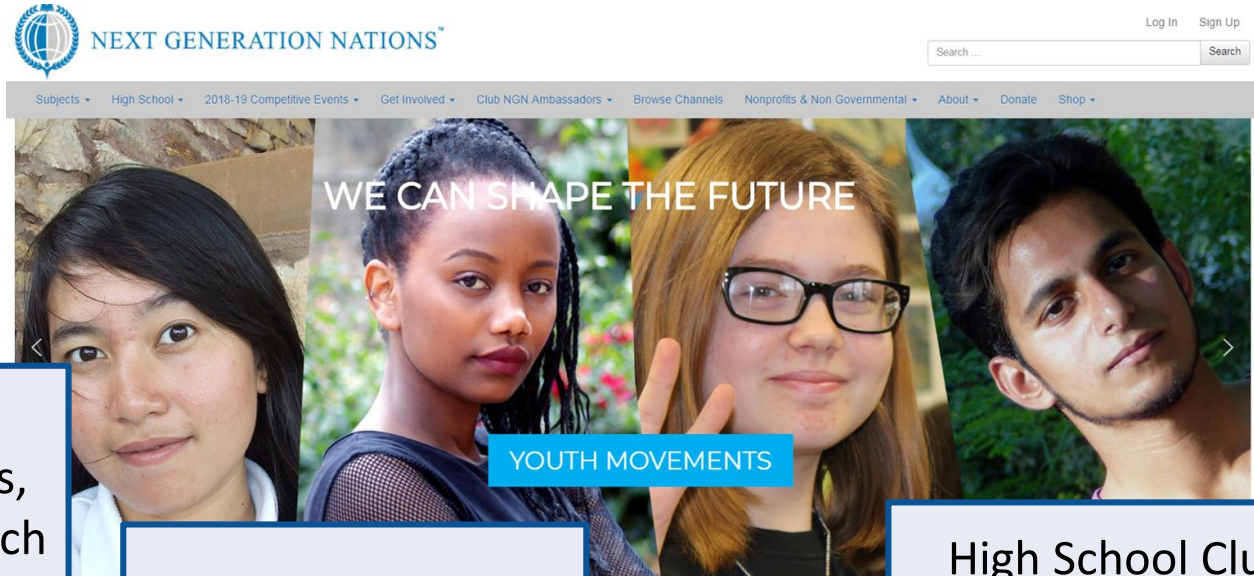

Club NGN	Other Clubs
<p>Program = systematic & well organized</p> <p>Corporate visit, Community service, Competition</p>	<p>Other clubs = not balanced</p> <p>Either community services or fundraising or competition</p>
<p>Unique concept “integration of social impact entrepreneurship + STEM + POLICY”</p>	<p>Entrepreneurship OR Social Impact Programs</p>
<p>Opportunity for “any student” to think and act on big ideas and present to corporate executives and investors</p>	<p>A few or almost no clubs are offering such an opportunity</p>
<p>NGN.ORG platform offers volunteerism profile, own channel ID → showcase causes you care for</p>	<p>Other clubs do not have an E platform where club activities are reported</p>
<p>Offers true corporate connections – interact with judges during and after event</p>	<p>Rarely you get an opportunity to interact with judges</p>
<p>High quality judges = corporate ambassadors, entrepreneurs, investors, professionals</p>	<p>Most of clubs don’t pay attention too much attention to quality of judges → usually are parents</p>

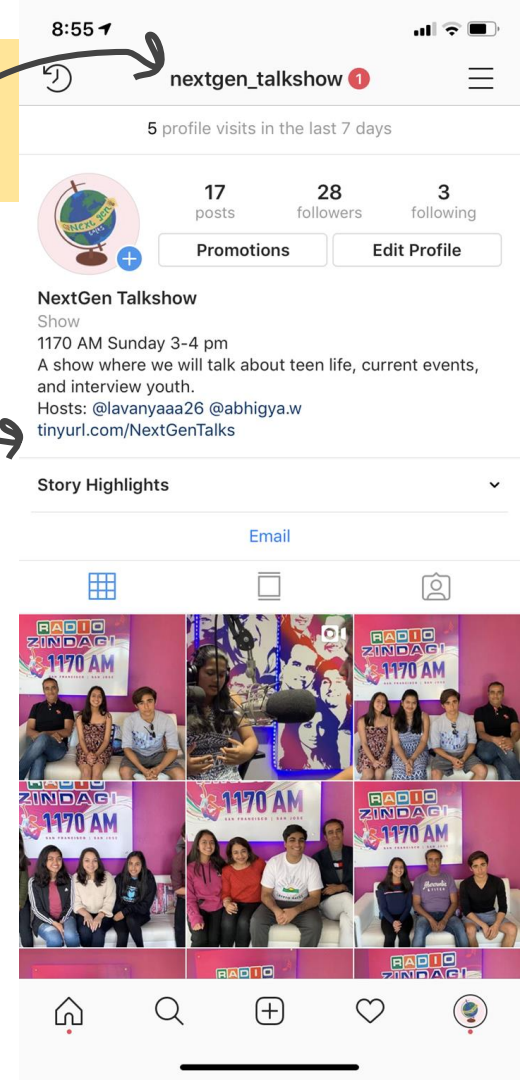
